Board Policy Statement

To the extent permitted by legislation, the University will set tuition fees in support of the University's long-term self-sufficiency goals.

Philosophy

The University's goal is to operate without government funding.

President's Responsibilities

The President will oversee the development of a tuition fee schedule consistent with the mandate of Royal Roads University and with principles established by the Board of Governors.

Information, Action and Monitoring Requirements for the Board

The Board will approve, annually, the schedule of tuition fees.

The Board will receive, for information, updates about tuition fee trends within the post-secondary education sector, as appropriate.
